Juniors do battle at Aldwickbury Park

A thrilling finish in the Spring Cup saw Tom Norman age, 16 win his first piece of silverware in an Aldwickbury Park competition.

Conor Maher age, 15 and Ryan Carbonero age, 14 both finished their rounds with 40 stableford points and were preparing for the looming play-off, when Tom, playing in the final group of the day, came in with a magnificent 42 points to take both the trophy and the Ping putter donated by sponsors TruGreen.

There was another tight finish in the Junior Open, where 84 youngsters from across Hertfordshire travelled to compete.

Winner Jordan Shepherd from Brickenden Grange Golf Club took the honours after winning a play-off on the 10th hole against Chadwell Springs' Ryan Coxall.

It was a great day for Shepherd who also won the morning round of the *Daily Telegraph* Abu Dhabi Championship with a one-under-par 72. His win sees him through to the regional qualifying final for the championship, one of the world's best tournament for golfers under-18.

Simon Folbigg, Aldwickbury Park Sales and Marketing Manager, said: "There was some amazing golf played by the youngsters over the two competitions. Congratulations to both Jordan and Tom for winning, and also to Aldwickbury Park member Sheila Waltham, who, with help from the junior committee, organised the Junior Open.
