1) Matters Arising from Previous Minutes

- 1.1 The position of the mat on the 7th will be reviewed before the Autumn **SN**
- 1.2 SN will have another look at the positioning of the yellow plaque on the 13th, but it is exactly where the previous plaque was! **SN**
- 1.3 Lady tee markers are now in place and permanent replacements have been ordered.
- 1.4 The practice nets are to be replaced and the lagging around the scaffold to be secured, **SN**
- 1.5 Over 80's subs to be compared with other local clubs **AH**

2) Course Matters

- 2.1 The greens were due to be double cut tomorrow, which should increase speed.
- 2.2 There was a radical spraying for clover planned over the next two weeks, both on fairways and the rough.
- 2.3 A review of the bunkers would take place and corrective action (if required) planned, but this could take some time.
- 2.4 SW asked if there were plans to “pretty up” the 1st hole, TH said that kerb appeal was important to Burhill Estates and they would do what was necessary to address this.
- 2.5 The trench across the 1st & 6th will be refilled until the dip disappears **SN**
- 2.6 There is some new equipment on trial at present, when the older equipment is replaced, it will increase productivity significantly allowing the green keeping team to do more in the same time.

3) New Owners

TH repeated that the new owners have every intention of raising standards at APGC to cover all aspects of the Club. They will do what they see as the right thing for the Owners, the Staff, and the Members.

4) Club Constitution

RL and SW explained why we had attempted to get the current constitution amended, and gave TH a copy, he agreed to take it away and have a look at it, and get back to us. **TH**

5) Security

TH had asked for a complete review of club security and action will follow shortly. **TH**

6) Shop Hours

RL reported that currently the Shop opens at 7.30 but the course opens at 7.15, leaving it impossible for players with early tee times to get in the locker room. TH asked SH to ensure that the shop, during the summer, would open at 6.45 **SH**

7) Any Other Business

Could the height of the steps on the 15th tee be increased, as there is still dead ground, which could lead to a serious accident **SN**
