MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

The minutes of the last Meeting were approved

MATTERS ARISING

PSI Computer.	PHH to remind Tristan about backup Stuart Hatch to be reminded to take off the leader board facility
Mixed Medals	Not awarded if less than 7 entries but kept as a qualifier
Matchplay	PHH confirmed that the Herts Golf Union said that from 2008 single match play events should be played off full handicap
Club Championship	It was confirmed that the 9 hole results should not have been input into the computer and any member that had done it should have that result ignored
Match Play	It was confirmed that male winners of match play events (singles and doubles k.o finals) would be adjusted by one shot

COURSE MATTERS

Schedule of Works	The management to be asked whether there could be more communication on impending major works such as hollow tining of the greens
Pin Positions	There were complaints that too many pin positions were at the front of the green and at this time of the year they should be in the middle or back
Tee Block Position	The green keepers keep putting the tee blocks either side of a sprinkler head. This should be avoided. In addition they were still putting white tees on the yellow tee position on competition days
Par3s	A question was asked whether the club could provide a seed box to improve the tee
Bunker Rakes	There were a number of bunkers that had missing rakes. Was there an alternative?
Bunkers	The committee welcomed the work currently being done but the 14 th bunker was still out of play
Mid Month Stpfd	Due to the tees being all off the whites h/c should not be adjusted but it should count as a qualifier
17th Hole	There was discussion concerning the 17 th Hole and whether the appearance and difficulty could be improved by the addition of some bunkers at the front. To be discussed at the members meeting
