### **Minutes of Meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> August 2007**

Addition to minutes: Following reports from the gents' committee last month, a discussion was held on whether the allocation of handicaps to new members required a certain standard of play. It was decided this was not necessary as the Monday mix-in and Fun competitions allowed assistance and support to be given to encourage and assist new members to raise their game and improve their score.

### **Matters Arising:**

The Club Handicap Committee has still not invited any APGC Ladies representative to attend. This will be pursued, as it is felt that it would be helpful if not necessary for us to know the focus for discussion so that the ladies' committee can discuss and hold views on the same topics.

**Course matters:** The weeds (Ragwort) in rough areas are being mown and further weed killer will be applied. Pin Positions: these are set according to a predetermined plan. **Six red, six yellow and six white alternated every day on two positions on each green.** It was suggested that it might be useful to have a copy of this plan available to members. Tee Markers: It has been pointed out to the Greenkeeper that these are sometimes in questionable positions. The men have a similar problem. **P.K. sent a photograph to the management, highlighting the point in the positioning of the eighth tee markers pointing towards the hedge, in the week leading up to the meeting** Course layout: this will not be changed. In due course the 1<sup>st</sup> Tee is to be given a more prominent profile. However, before this happens, drainage work is being carried out in the autumn.

### **Competitions and Events**

1. Lady Captain's Day: it was seen as being a great success and really enjoyed by all. One minor point re lunch – some of the brochettes were too hard and the final team had short rations. **This complaint was passed on to the catering staff.**
2. Jubilee trophy: Because the date has been changed, 5-day members who were previously playing on a Monday are being allowed to play on the Sunday.
3. Captain/Vice Captain: 2 more players required.
4. No problems with Tin/Silver/Gold cups as yet. **P.K. asked for everyone to keep an eye on this change to the previous year's diary.**
5. Medals: these have been given visibly higher priority and there will be some form of acknowledgement at the Prize Presentation evening.

### **Future**

Friendlies 2008 – There has been no replacement yet for Hanbury Manor but the date will be kept in the diary. At this committee's request P.S. has approached other clubs.

Barbara Hatch is taking over Seniors' Matches.

Pearson: dates for 2008 now available – 4 before Christmas and the rest after. Anne Roche is taking over as Pearson Captain. The fixtures are being organised and will be put in the new diary.
