3.Matters Arising

Ladies Committee Meeting

- The tee block on the 8th has been moved.
- The brush for shoes is in place outside the clubhouse.
- Management had not taken further action over holding a Ladies` Open Day.

Captains' Committee Meeting.

- Notifications of the Club and Ladies AGM.s have been posted on the Management and Ladies notice boards.
- New Club signage is in place and improved new signage on the course will be dealt with in the coming year.
- Bunkers with a GUR sign or a white line painted around them are out of play, but all other bunkers are in use and should be played in accordance with the rules of golf. It is hoped that work on all the worst bunkers will be completed by the end of March.
