Local Rules - Park Course

The Local Rules and any Temporary Local Rules currently in force as displayed in the clubhouse take precedence over the abridged Rules printed here.

Out of Bounds (Rule 27 - 1)

Beyond all course boundaries or beyond any line of white stakes defining OOB

Water Hazards (Rule 26)

Are defined by stakes which lie within the margin of the hazard.

18th Hole: If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the lateral water hazard adjacent to the 18th green, the player MAY:

- (i) proceed under Rule 26 - 1; or if a ball in the lateral water hazard last crossed the margin of the hazard between the red posts painted with a white top,
- (ii) as an **additional** option, the player MAY, under penalty of one stroke, drop a ball in the dropping zone.

Protection of Young Trees

If a young tree, identified by being supported or protected by a stake or other device such as a tube or rabbit cage, interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b.

Abnormal Ground Conditions (Rule 25 - 1)

A player MAY take relief without penalty from GUR marked by white lines.

Tree plantations, as defined by the areas enclosed by blue stakes, are GUR (Rule 25-1) from which play is prohibited and relief MUST be taken. If a player's ball lies in any of these areas, or a blue stake interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, relief (without penalty) is as follows: the player MUST lift the ball and drop it within the nearest dropping zone, no nearer the pin.

Bunkers

Stones in Bunkers are movable obstructions. (Rule 24 - 1 applies)

Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24 - 2 applies)

All **roads and pathways** are integral parts of the course with the exception of:

all artificially surfaced paths; stony path on right hand side of 1st Teeing Ground to the 150 yard marker, continuing in front of the 2nd, 3rd & 4th Teeing Grounds and continuing to the 5th Teeing Ground; stony path on left hand side of 10th Teeing Ground, continuing through the avenue of trees to meet & include the path from the 17th Green to the 18th Teeing Ground; stony path from the 16th Teeing Ground up the left hand side of 16th hole to the 17th Teeing Ground.

13th Hole: The hedge path on the green side of the hedge is an immovable obstruction (Rule 24-2 applies). As an **additional** relief option the player MAY use the dropping zone; Steps through hedge are immovable obstructions. [Your nearest point of relief MAY be in the hedge].

Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Greens (Rule 24-3)

Where the condition applies, in **addition** to relief without penalty under Rule 24-2, relief is also available as set out in the R&A Rules of Golf, Appendix I Part B Section 6.

Penalty for Breach of Local Rule:

Match Play - Loss of Hole; Strokeplay - 2 strokes

Distance Measuring Devices

For all play at APGC a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. (Rule 14 - 3 applies). **Penalty: Disqualification**

Information:

Thunder & Lightning: Leave the course. No klaxon will be sounded.

Flag Colours: Red front. Yellow middle. White back.

Please repair pitch marks, replace divots and rake bunkers after use.
